

# Small Animal Rules

1. SMALL ANIMALS WILL BE RECEIVED FROM 11:00 A.M. THURSDAY, AND MUST BE IN PLACE BEFORE 6:30 P.M. THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 10th.
  2. All entries are subject to the rules and regulations as listed in the exhibitor list of the Hebron Harvest Fair.
  3. Poultry and waterfowl must be at least 5 months old and rabbits must be at least 8 weeks old in order to be shown. No does with litters will be accepted. Rabbit entries limited to 20 per family.
  4. Food and water will be supplied by the Hebron Harvest Fair for poultry, waterfowl and rabbits only. Waterfowl exhibitors must furnish their own water containers. Rabbit exhibitors must furnish weighted feed and water crocks.
  5. Only healthy animals may be shown. Any animal showing signs of sickness or disease will not be allowed to enter.
  6. The best possible care will be taken of all exhibits, but the Hebron Harvest Fair will not be responsible for any injury, accidents, mistakes, fire, theft or sickness of any animal in this department.
  7. Those aged 16 and under may enter the Junior Department. Same prize money as seniors.
  8. This is not an ARBA sanctioned show, nor a professional poultry show. However, poultry will be judged by the American Poultry and Bantam Standards of Perfections on only the first three of each breed and variety of sex.
  9. Pet stock will be accepted in both Poultry and Rabbits, but must be indicated as so on entry form, please make sure you enter in proper class. Pets must be securely housed, fed and watered by the exhibitor.
  10. Prize money will be given before 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 13, 2009. Signs will be posted as soon as the money is available
  11. The Superintendent will in no way be involved in the sale of animals. Animals for sale and exhibition cannot be removed until coop out time, Sunday, September 13, 2009 at 5:30 p.m.
  12. Small animals will be received starting at 11:00 a.m., but must be placed before 6:30 p.m., Thursday September 10, 2009. No small animals may be removed before 5:50 p.m., Sunday, September 13, 2009.
  13. Exhibitors having at least 10 animal entries in any department within the fair may receive one three-day pass and a parking pass.
  14. All entries should be sent to: Domenic or Hedwig Porto, 95 Preston Avenue, Middletown, CT 06457. Entries close when pens are full. Entry deadline is Wednesday, August 12, 2009.
  15. A trophy will be awarded for Best Standard, Best Bantam, Best Waterfowl, Best Pet Poultry, Best Pet Rabbit and Best Purebred Rabbit.
- Note:** for 2009 entries limited to CT birds, poultry and waterfowl.
