

# Goat Show Rules

1. Animals must be penned between 3:00 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. Thursday, September 10th. No late entries will be accepted.
2. Every person entering the fairgrounds must have a valid pass, season ticket, or they must purchase a gate ticket. Exhibitors will be given ONE pass to the fair. Exhibitors sixteen years or younger may be given one additional pass for their parent or a driver of the vehicle.
3. Entry blanks must be filled out completely or they will not be accepted. Including Goat breed.
4. Animals must remain on grounds until 5:30 p.m. Sunday, unless released by the superintendent, or prize money will be forfeited.
5. No goats with horns will be allowed on the fairgrounds.
6. Entries must be clean and fitted.
7. Age of animals as of September 1st. Please indicate animals' birth dates on entry blank.
8. An entry may be rejected due to health reasons.
9. Exhibitors must supply their own feed and care. Bedding will be provided, but limited amounts.
10. Showmanship classes will be judged as preferred by the judge.
11. Entries must be received by September 1st. Entries close when pens are full.
12. Classes may be altered at superintendent's discretion.
13. Decoration and informative displays are encouraged and welcome. Please see the superintendent to be sure space is available. All displays will be suspended from the rafters or on the side walls – **NO FLOOR DISPLAYS.**
14. Herdsman Award at the discretion of the superintendent.
15. No net or macramé type hay feeders.
16. **NOTE: PARKING** – For livestock trailers and trucks will be in a designated area behind barns.
17. Health charts to be submitted with entry or entry will not be accepted.
18. No more than 10 goats per farm or family.
