

Dairy and Beef Show Rules

1. All animals will be on the grounds by 7:30 p.m. Thursday, September 10th, in the assigned exhibit space and will remain on the grounds until 6:00 p.m. Sunday. Early removal of animals without special consent from the superintendent will result in the forfeit of premiums earned.
2. Show time for Dairy Cattle is 9:00 a.m. Sunday.
3. Show time for Beef: Cattle is 9:00 am Saturday.
4. Certificates of Registration must be available upon request.
5. All state regulations regarding the showing of dairy and beef animals will be strictly adhered to.
6. Exhibitors will not interfere with the judges or committee while animals are being judged.
7. Where there is no competition, the judge will award ribbons and prize money where he sees fit.
8. The superintendent reserves the right to reject any cattle entry if it is deemed advisable.
9. Exhibitors are encouraged to submit new entry forms early; however, entries will only be accepted between July 1, 2009 and August 1, 2010. Entries may close earlier than August 1 if spaces are filled.
10. All entries must be in writing on the New Entry Form for 2010 and should be mailed to the superintendent of livestock.
11. Every person entering the fairgrounds must have a valid pass, season ticket, or they must purchase a gate ticket. Exhibitors will be given ONE pass to the fair. Exhibitors sixteen years or younger may obtain one additional season ticket for their parent, or a driver of a vehicle.
12. Junior show exhibitors must be under the age of 19 as of January 1, 2010.
13. Junior competition eligibility will depend on registration or lease papers dated by May 9, 2010. In the case of crossbred beef animals, a bill of sale dated by May 9, 2010 will suffice.
14. Bulls may be shown with limitations. They must be born after January 1, 2010 and can only be entered in the group classes – Get of Sire, Produce of Dam and Cow-Calf Pair.
15. Limit of two entries per exhibitor per class. Limit of ten head per exhibitor.
16. Bedding will be provided, but in limited amounts.
